Sir,

As Central Government by notification, constituted a Commission, to be known as the National Commission for Homoeopathy, to exercise the powers conferred upon, and to perform the functions assigned to it, under NCH Act 2020. As per section 59 (2) of NCH Act, 2020, following has been stated:

"Notwithstanding the repeal of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act 1973, the educational and medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder: Provided that anything done or any action taken as regards the educational and medical standards and requirements under the enactment under repeal and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the corresponding provision of this Act and shall continue in force accordingly unless and until superseded by anything or by any action taken under this Act".

As per provision in the Act, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy has been constituted with the mandate to grant permission to the existing and new medical institution of Homoeopathy. Accordingly, it is to inform you that all the relevant documents submitted by your college in Part-1 proforma were examined by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.

On careful consideration of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board has arrived at the following conclusion:-

That the applicant has set up a Homoeopathic Medical College with the component of staff, infrastructure, equipment and instruments and other facilities where as the College has to take urgent and time bound steps to implement Minimum Standard Requirements of the Homoeopathy College and attached Hospital as prescribed by the National Commission for Homoeopathy for conducting BHMS course in Homoeopathy. The deficiencies observed are as follows.



Dr. Andhalgadnkar M. S. Principal Gandhi Natha Rangji Homoeopathic 1. Hospital Staff: Lab Technician 01 is not available.

2. Hospital equipment:

- i. Iron beds (Simple, Surgical & Pediatrics) 05 is not available
- ii. Stretcher with trolley 03 is not available
 - iii. Oxygen cylinder with stand 02 is not available
 - iv. Diagnostic set (ENT) 03 is not available

3. Teaching faculty.

<u>UG courses</u>: Total 24 full time faculty provided by college out of which only 20 found eligible.

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Discrepancies in engagement of teachers are as below:

- i. Dr. Sunil Anantrao Bhoasle, Lecturer (MD Organon 2011) (Anatomy)- joined as lecturer on 13.1.14 and date of birth is 9.9.70. age exceeding 40 years at the time of joining as lecturer.
- ii. Dr. Shrikant Murlidhar Kulkarni, Professor, Organon- Date of birth is 20.5.56. Age exceeding 65 years of age.
- iii. Dr. Rajashree Bhalchandra Shelgikar, Lecturer (DHMS-97) (Obstetric & Gynecologist)- joined as lecturer on 23.7.13. He has no PG degree.
 - iv. Dr. Rajesh Iranappa Anagire, Lecturer (DHMS-97) (Community Medicine)-joined as lecturer on 13.1.14. Date of birth is 1.6.71. He has no PG degree also age exceeding 40 years at the time of joining as lecturer.

<u>Guest Faculty</u>: Total 12 Guest faculty provided by the college out of which no guest faculty is found eligible.

Discrepancies in engagement of teachers are as below:

i. Previous full time teaching experience of Guest Professor/ Reader in the department of Anatomy, Physiology, Organon, Pharmacy, Materia Medica, Pathology, Forensic Medicine & Toxicology, Practice of Medicine, Surgery, Obstetric & Gynecologist, Community Medicine and Repertory.

<u>Part Time Teachers</u>: Total 09 part time teachers provided by college out of which NIL is observed.

- 4. College laboratories: Chemical Balance 09 (in Pharmacy) is not available. Mummified bodies (in Anatomy) are also not available in the college.
- 5. Miscellaneous:
 - i. Documents for Biometric Attendance is not provided.
 - ii. EPF/PF /ESI deductions of teachers, non teaching staff & hospital staff- deducted (17 members challan of Sept. to Nov. 2020 provided.
 - iii. Form-16 of teachers, non teaching staff & hospital staff- provided of 16 teachers.
 - iv. 12 teachers are getting salary less than Rs.10000/-
- 6. Website: http://www.gnrhmcsolapur.org is functioning and student data not updated as checked on dated 08.10.2021 (Website last update dated: 24.08.2021)
- 3. After considering the provisions of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and HCC(MSR) Regulations, 2013, Permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board is issued to Gandhi Natha Rangaji Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, 13, Budhawar Peth, Jain Boarding Campus, Balives, Solapur-413002 Maharashtra for continuing admissions in 1 BHMS course with intake capacity of 50 seats during the academic year 2021-22. The principal is directed to fulfill the deficiencies within three months and an affidavit in this regard may be submitted to the Medical Assessment Board within a period of one week.
- 4. All admissionsinUnder Graduate/Post graduate course shall be through NEET only. It is further informed that, minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India quota. The counseling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling Authority of State / UT Government as

designated by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling Authority of that State / UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the student admitted thereunder.

- 5. The category wise list of selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board as per rules.
- 6. The college has to comply with the full requirements of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 for conducting the course. All deficiencies observed and mentioned above which affects the performance of the academic Institution, through which College fails to fulfill the statutory requirements, has to be rectified within three months' time from issue of this permission letter. Compliance report shall be submitted by the college to Medical Assessment and Rating Boardaccordingly. Subsequently, theBoard shall verify the compliance well in time and may conduct Online/Physical inspection for verification of compliance as per the HCC (MSR) Regulation, 2013 and will consider admissions for the academic year 2022-23.

The college is not authorized to admit the students for 1st year of the course until receipt of permission of the National Commission for Homoeopathy, New Delhi/Govt. of India/Department of AYUSH, New Delhi.
- 2) The admission shall be done only through the Competent Authorities.
